



**CITY OF LAKE FOREST PARK
DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
WAC 197-11-970**

Description of proposal: The City of Lake Forest Park is proposing to update Chapters 16.08, 16.16, and 16.24 of the Lake Forest Park Municipal Code which regulate clearing and grading activities, environmentally sensitive areas, and drainage regulations. These changes are being made primarily to update the regulations to comply with the Department of Ecology's NPDES Permit.
