**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF LAKE FOREST PARK, WASHINGTON REGARDING
THE 2009 DOCKET OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, there are no applications to amend the comprehensive plan on the docket for comprehensive plan amendments other than the City-initiated proposed changes to address the Council adoption of the Legacy 100-Year Vision: Final Report; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission did not find contradictions between the Legacy 100-Year Vision and the Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has limited staff resources to process the Legacy-related amendments at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department is expending significant staff resources to ensure that the proposed Shoreline Management Plan Update and Low Impact Development provisions are ready for adoption prior to mandated deadlines this year; and

WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act requires a mandatory review and update of the City's Comprehensive Plan in 2011;

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE FOREST
PARK AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the City Council has determined that in the year 2009 planning staff and planning commission resources are better allocated to the preparation of the Shoreline Management Plan Update and the Low Impact Development provisions; and

2. That the City Council directs the Planning Director not to place the Legacy-related amendments on the docket for comprehensive plan amendments, and that planning director shall not forward a 2009 Comprehensive Plan Amendment Docket to the Planning Commission.
