TRAIL WITHIN LAKE FOREST PARK**

TO RECEIVE TESTIMONY PERTINENT TO THIS PROPOSAL**

Application has been made by King County Department of Parks, Cultural, and Natural Resources to the City of Lake Forest Park for a Conditional Use Permit (File number CU07-01), Sensitive Areas Public Agency Exceptions (File number SA07-162), and a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit (File number SSD07-04) for the following location:

**Burke Gilman Trail, Lake Forest Park, WA 98155  
Tax Parcel Nos. 102604-9016 and 152604-9003**

The application requests a Conditional Use Permit to resurface and widen the Burke Gilman Trail, a regional trail corridor that runs through Lake Forest Park. The trail will be widened from 10 feet to 12 feet and will involve work in steep slopes, wetlands and streams and their buffer areas.

King County Facilities Management Division issued a Final Environmental Impact Statement for the project on June 25, 2008. At this time, the Lake Forest Park Planning Department is recommending approval of the requests with conditions. **The consolidated public hearing will begin at 6:00 PM on Wednesday, January 21, 2009 with the applicant's presentation; the public comment portion of the hearing will begin at 7:00 PM. If the hearing cannot be concluded on the 21st, it will be reconvened at 6:00 PM on Monday, January 26th. The Hearing Examiner has imposed time limits on testimony at this hearing: Each speaker will be limited to not more than three (3) minutes; time is not cumulative and may not be given to others. The Examiner may relax the time limits depending upon hearing attendance. Lengthy testimony may be submitted in written form.**

If the Hearing Examiner approves this application, the applicant will still need approval of all applicable permits through the Lake Forest Park Planning and Building Department prior to starting work including, but not limited to, a Building Permit, a Sensitive Areas Permit and a Clearing and Grading Work Permit.

**Written comments may be submitted to the Hearing Examiner for review and must be received by 3:00 P.M., Tuesday, January 20, 2009, or submitted during the public hearing.
