Commissioners discussed Lake Forest Park goes to the Movies event. Tim Walsh has rented the barbecues and popcorn machine. The church will allow us to use their electricity from their manse. Steve Hanegan will construct the stage and screen. He will pick up the projector. Mary Beth Davis will order the film and place posters around the mall. She will survey commissioners for the film they want.

Commissioners discussed the need to have a park in the south end of the City. The Gateway community would be a good spot. Commissioners agreed to have Chair Florence Wright write a letter to the Council indicating support for the playground as part of the senior housing zoning overlay.

Commissioners agreed to the location of a bench at Horizon View purchased from Stewardship Foundation auction. They also agreed to have a sign at Animal Acres indicating the distance around the park loop.

Commissioners reviewed application for Starbuck's grant and did not think that we could apply this year. There are no projects in the City that are eligible for it.
