Notes from previous meeting approved.

Strategy for determining property acquisitions for park space:

- Members reviewed the Parks Inventory and Classification and recommended some changes for the Comprehensive Plan. It was recommended that Horizon View Park should be a community park as opposed to a neighborhood park. Also Shorecrest tennis courts should be included in the “tennis court” count.
- Members looked at a city map with the various park locations.
- Tom Kellock and Florence Wright will make a site visit to the Seattle Water District land. They will report back on whether it has the potential for a city recreational site if and when Seattle sells it.

Landscaping for the fountain at Animal Acres:

City public works parks team will be working on a landscaping plan for the fountain. This will be presented to the commission/

Update on Brookside Elementary School:

The Mayor has recommended \$2,000 for the Brookside School playground in the 2005 budget. This is the same amount that the city donated to Lake Forest Park Elementary School.

Lights at Lake Forest Park tennis courts

The commissioners recommended that the capital budget for the Lake Forest Park Elementary school tennis courts include energy efficient lights.

Commissioners expressed interest in having a youth commissioner for any vacant spot on the Parks and Recreation commission.
