

RESOLUTION NO. 1108

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE FOREST PARK, WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING THE LAKE FOREST PARK LEGACY 100-YEAR VISION AS THE PRINCIPAL GUIDE FOR THE CITY'S PARKS AND OPEN SPACE PLANNING

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Forest Park's Comprehensive Plan calls for the city to be a model for preservation of the environment and our natural resources with the surrounding urbanized region, and,

WHEREAS, the City's core principles include preserving the environment and natural resources; inspiring a sense of community; encouraging development that is in harmony with its surroundings; and providing and encouraging a variety of transportation alternatives, and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted a priority list that includes consideration of Legacy project recommendations, and,

WHEREAS, the City's parks master plan requires updating, and,

WHEREAS, the Legacy 100-Year Vision provides a direction for how Lake Forest Park should evolve in the near, intermediate and far future, and,

WHEREAS, substantial additional detailed planning is necessary on specific Legacy project ideas to determine their cost, feasibility and impacts.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Lake Forest Park:

1. hereby adopts the Legacy 100-Year Vision as the City's Parks and Recreation Open Space Plan that together with the Recreation and Open Space element of the city's comprehensive plan provides the City with a 6-year plan as required for state funding projects;
2. assigns the Planning Commission the task of determining possible updates necessary to the the Comprehensive Plan and recommend these for future Council action;
3. will use the framework and guidelines as outlined in the Legacy 100-year Vision in its review of future budgets and capital improvement plans;

4. will use the framework, guidelines, and established criteria as outlined in the Legacy 100-year Vision in its review of future property acquisition and redevelopment of existing infrastructure;

5. will continue working in coordination with the community on implementation of the goals outlined in the Legacy 100-year vision; and,

6. will conduct site and vicinity planning for specific Legacy projects that will include a detailed process to identify and assess impacts on adjoining properties and neighborhoods and include appropriate means to involve local residents in such planning.

The City Council of the City of Lake Forest Park, Washington approves and authorizes the Mayor to sign this resolution.
