37 Park & Ride Possibility: Commissioner Wright stated that the administration expressed

41 Options & Recommendations for Mayor re: Boat Trailer & RV Long Term Parking on City
42 ROW: Commissioners engaged in a long discussion on the topic (again) and agreed that
43 the Commission's position is that the existing code language is adequate, the only
44 necessary change is to modify the Municipal Code to include a definition of public right of
45 way.

1 Shoreline Trails Advisory Group: Commissioner Bilski stated that Shoreline's City
2 Council has approved routes and that Shoreline staff is developing a comprehensive
3 nonmotorized plan.

5 McKinnon Creek Trail & Lake Forest Park Water District: Commissioner Wright
6 described his communications with City administration and reported the mayor and city
7 administrator are reluctant to proceed with the project at this time.

9 New Transportation Commissioners Needed: Commissioner McCormack noted that he
10 still knows a person who is interested in becoming a commissioner who intended to
11 attend the meeting this evening but was unfortunately ill.

13 METRO Transit Service Cuts: Commissioners discussed how METRO has indicated that
14 some of the routes preliminarily scheduled for service cuts will be restored and that
15 METRO has somehow been able to find some money somewhere to make this happen.

19 Bus Stop at SR522/NE 165th Street: Nobody has heard anything new on METRO's
20 desire to remove the bus stop at this intersection. Commissioner Altman stated he would
21 contact METRO and ask the status.
