Pipeline installation to begin

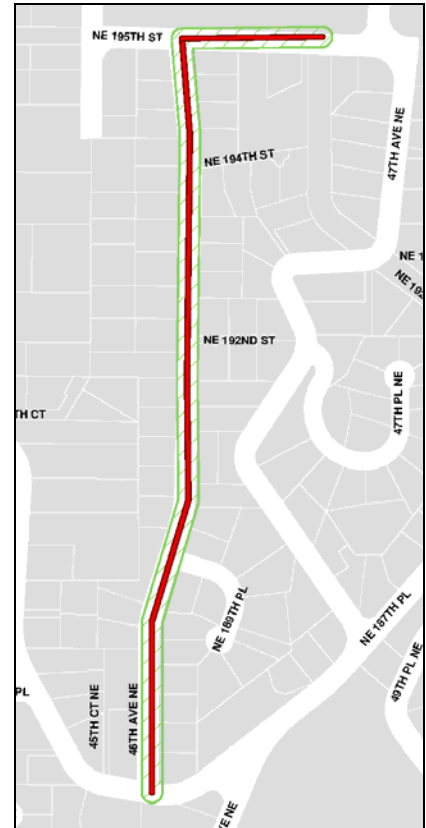
Starting the week of Jan 19, 2009 a contractor working for King County will begin installation of a water pipeline along NE 195th Street, west of 47th Ave NE, and along 46th Ave. NE, between NE 195th Street and 45th Place NE.

Work will include:

- Pipeline installation using cut and cover method
- Installation of small facilities associated with the pipeline
- Re-paving of areas that have been affected by pipeline installation

Approved hours of work are 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays. However, the contractor has indicated that they will be working Monday-Saturday mainly during daylight hours.

Traffic control: Because we will be working in the street, traffic controls will be in place. It is expected that the contractor will provide one way access with flaggers for most of the route, with only short delays. Individual driveway closures may occur for short periods of time. We will communicate and work with individual homeowners regarding their driveway and property access during this construction.

- Repaving is scheduled to be completed by mid-May
