

The Local Hazardous Waste Management Program ReUse Store

The Local Hazardous Waste Management Program's ReUse Store:

- The ReUse Store is a service of the Local Hazardous Waste Management Program in King County and is operated by Seattle Public Utilities. The ReUse Store provides common household products to King County residents, non-profit agencies, churches and community groups.
- The products available at the ReUse Store are items that were dropped off at regional household hazardous waste collection facilities. Rather than paying to dispose of these still-usable and less-harmful products, the Program is making them available to the public for reuse. There are no fees charged at the ReUse Store for these products.
- Reusing these products saves money and reduces the need to generate new hazardous substances.
- **Household hazardous wastes are not accepted at the ReUse Store.** Household hazardous wastes must be taken to one of the Program's household hazardous waste facilities.

Store hours:

- Open to the **public** - Saturdays from 10 AM to 4 PM
- Open to **non-profits** - Monday - Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM, by appointment (by calling 206-386-4093)

Who Can Use the ReUse Store:

- The ReUse Store is open to residents, non-profit organizations, churches and community groups in King County.
- **Businesses and contractors are not eligible** to use the ReUse Store.

- Oil based paints, stains, and primer
- Wood care products
- Automotive products

- Household cleaning products (e.g. Pine Sol, Bleach, Toilet Cleaners)
