To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to request an exemption from Shoreline Substantial Development to repair an existing bulkhead and pier at the above referenced property on Lake Washington as shown on the enclosed drawings. The bulkhead will be repaired by replacing rocks along a 54 lineal foot section of the bulkhead. Crushed rock drainage material and filter fabric will be installed landward of the bulkhead. 25 cubic yards of spawning gravel mix will be added waterward of the bulkhead as mitigation. The existing pier will be repaired by splicing seven wood piles. We believe the project is exempt from substantial development as it is normal repair and maintenance of an existing structure which is exempt per W.A.C. 173-27-040 (2)(b).
