

RESOLUTION NO. 1718

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LAKE FOREST PARK, WASHINGTON, EXTENDING THE
EXISTING LOW INCOME SENIOR SEWER RATE
PROGRAM TO INCLUDE LOW INCOME DISABLED
CUSTOMERS**

WHEREAS, the City operates a sanitary sewer system within its territorial borders; and

WHEREAS, residential sewer customers are charged a flat monthly fee (billed bi-monthly) for sewer service; and

WHEREAS, sewer utility rates must be set to recover the full cost of operating and maintaining the sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the sewer utility has a long standing program established by Resolution 763 (2002) to offer reduced sewer rates for low income senior customers; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to expand the existing reduced rate program to include low income customers who are disabled; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes its authority to expand the reduced rate program as described in the preceding is authorized by RCW 74.38.070; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lake Forest Park, as follows:


Section 1. . LOW INCOME DISABLED SEWER RATE ESTABLISHED. The Mayor is authorized to offer a monthly sewer rate that is fifty percent (50.0%) of the regular residential rate to qualifying individuals. For the purposes of this resolution a qualifying individual is one who meets the income requirements set forth in Resolution 763 and has a permanent disability recognized by the Social Security Administration. All of the provisions of qualification for the low income disabled sewer rate are identical to those in Resolution 763 (2002), except the age requirement is replaced with a disability requirement.

Section 2. CORRECTIONS. The City Clerk is authorized to make necessary corrections to this resolution including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers and any references thereto.


