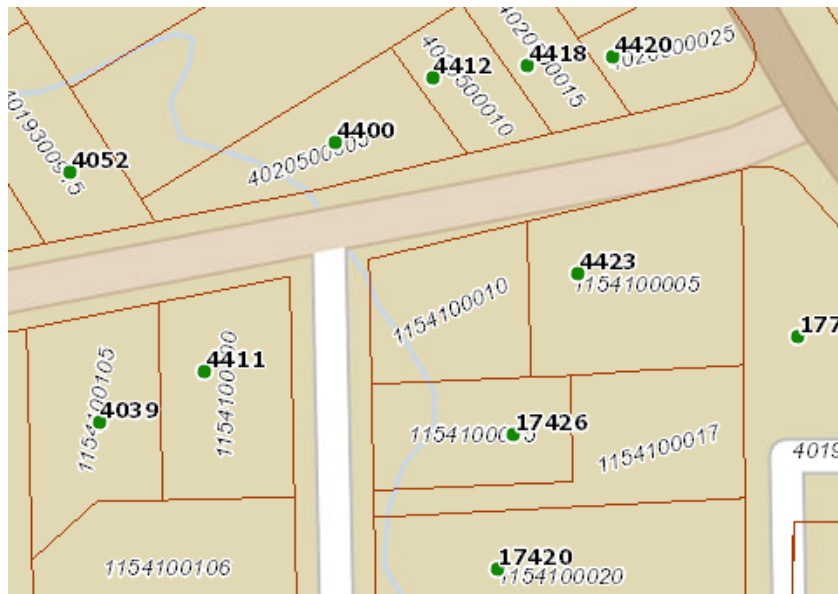

Proposal: Replace and upgrade a structurally deficient and partial fish barrier 96"x76" elliptical structural steel culvert (L60 Culvert) with a new 70-foot long fish passable pre-cast concrete box culvert and wing walls. Remove five trees within critical areas under separate permit. The project is located at the intersection of 44 AVE NE and NE 178 ST.

Environmental Review: The City of Lake Forest Park has reviewed the proposed project for probable adverse environmental impacts and has issued a determination of nonsignificance (DNS) using the optional DNS process (WAC 197-11-355) on July 24, 2019.

Appeals: This is a type III decision, and may be appealed to the Hearing Examiner by any person with standing per LFPMC 16.26.190. The decision of the Examiner is the final decision of the City. Please contact the City Clerk at 206-957-2811 for further information on how to file an appeal.
