Description of proposal: Amendments to the floodplain management regulations (Chapter 16.20 LFPMC) to bring them into compliance with the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and adopting updated Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM).
