
Police Department -

Notable Incidents

LFPPD worked with surrounding agencies, including WSP, regarding a response to the large gatherings of street racing, reckless driving, and intersection takeover behavior from the previous weekends. A large group attempted to take over areas in Shoreline and Seattle. Due to the efforts of all agencies, the vehicles were unable to conduct their illegal activities and ultimately dispersed without further incident.

Officers located a stolen vehicle occupied by two subjects. Officers discovered the driver was armed with a firearm. Both subjects were taken into custody without incident. Additional firearms and illegal drugs were located.

Officers responded to a loud explosion and discovered a commercial grade firework had been detonated in the front yard. Bomb Techs from King County and the FBI responded to assure there were no additional devices or bomb making materials. The known individual who ignited the explosive fled prior to PD arrival, likely due to multiple outstanding arrest warrants.
