



Help Save Bus Rapid Transit along SR 522!

Advocate for efficient and accessible transportation for all.

The cities of Bothell, Kenmore, Lake Forest Park and Shoreline are seeking interested community members to form a coalition of citizens and business leaders advocating for the timely delivery of the Sound Transit SR522/NE145th Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) project.

WHAT'S HAPPENING

Sound Transit is considering cutting the SR 522/NE 145th BRT project after projected revenue shortfalls from the pandemic as well as higher than anticipated project costs. We need citizens to remind the Sound Transit Board all of the reasons why this BRT project must stay funded and stay on schedule for completion in 2025.

KEY MESSAGES:

- **It's an important link in the regional transit system.** This project provides a crucial east-west connection to light rail and BRT on I-405. The SR 522/NE 145th BRT project provides a low-cost and efficient way to move residents, commuters, and students along this vital corridor.
- **It's cost effective.** Our cities have already built the road, bus lane and sidewalk infrastructure on SR522 to support the project and Sound Transit can take advantage of assets that are already available.
- **It's an early win for the Sound Transit 3 system expansion.** The project is scheduled to be completed in 2025, is within budget, and the public is supportive.
